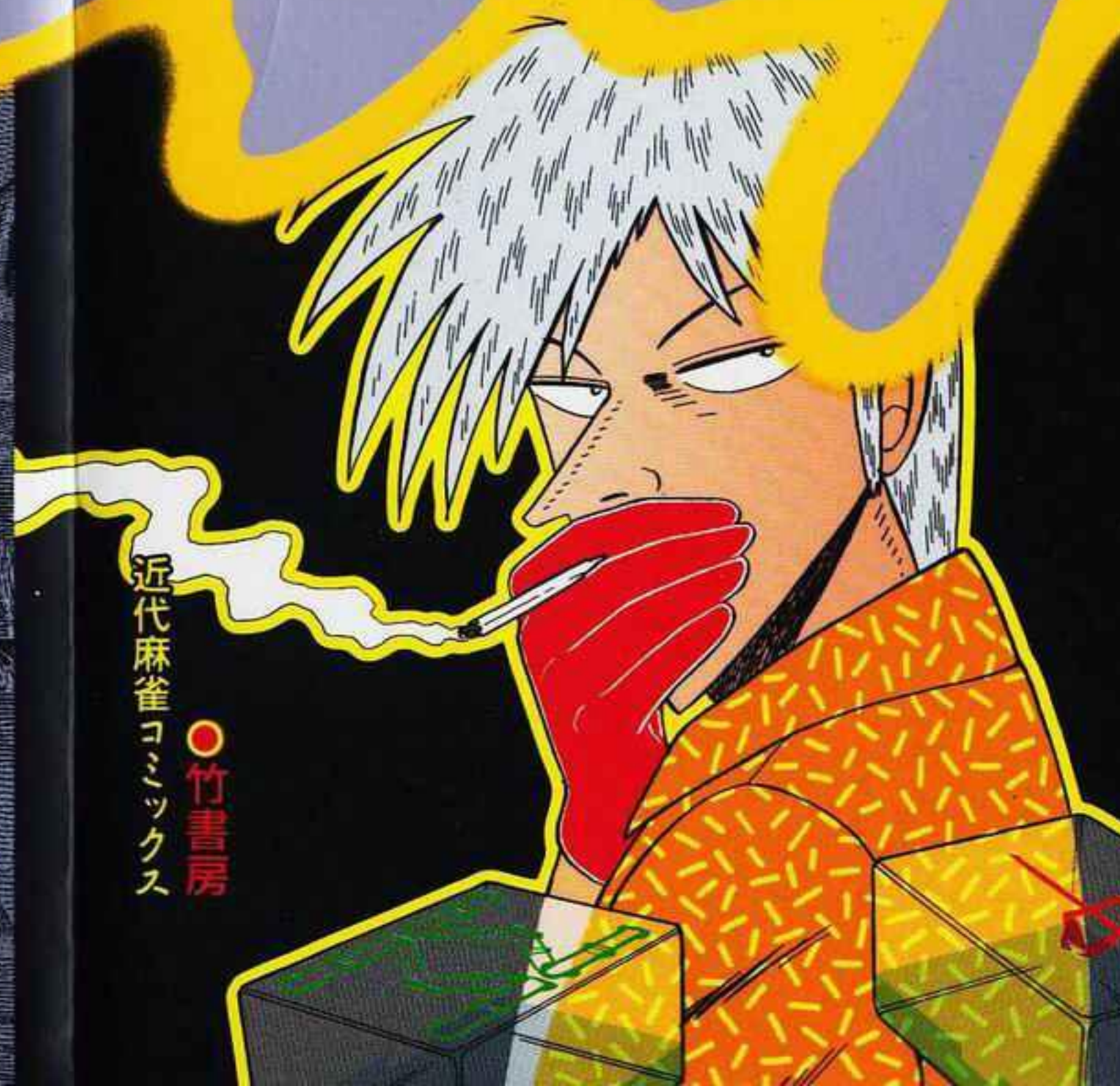

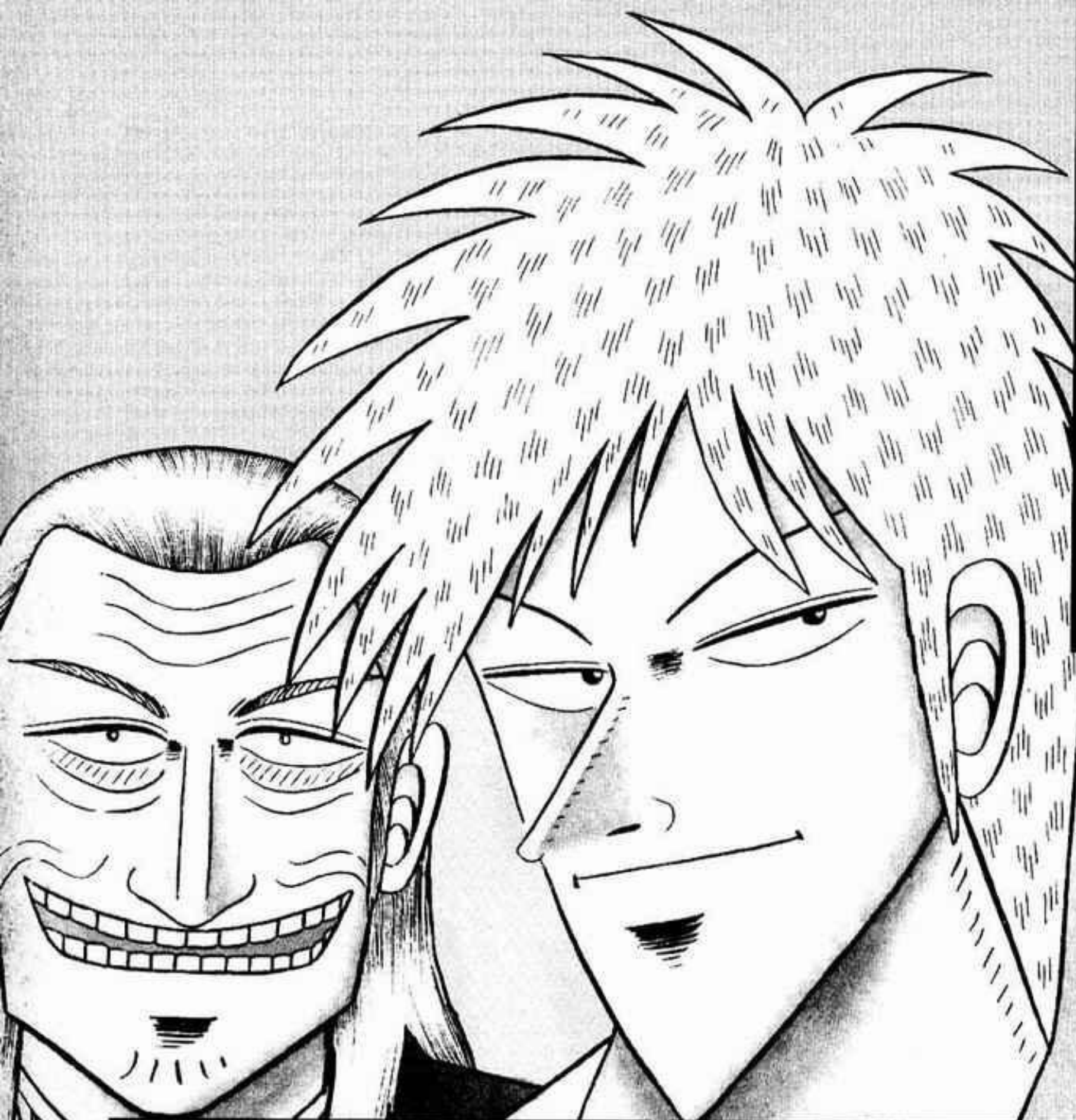

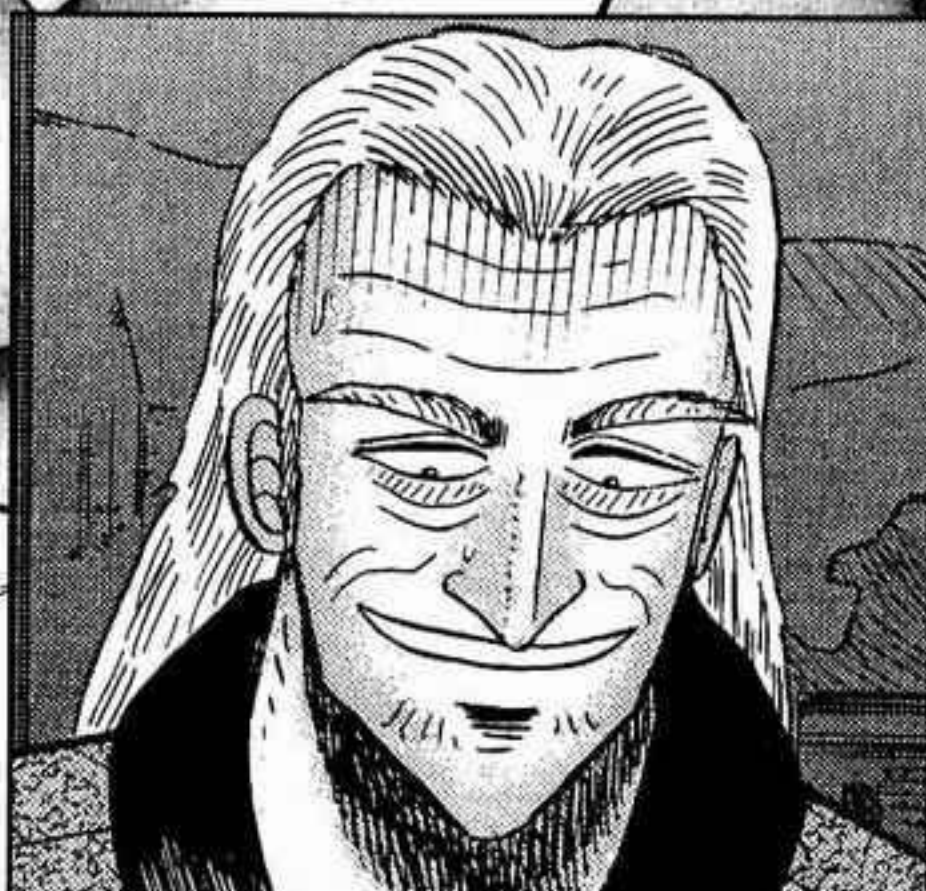

(鷺巣麻雀概要) 基本的にアカギが半荘6回戦を戦い抜けばアカギ側の勝利。途中でアカギが絶命すれば、それまでに得た現金も全て没収、鷺巣側の勝利となる。

- レート……1000点＝100万円
- 血液100cc。アカギと鷺巣のサシ勝負。ウマ(1万・3万)・オカを加算したポイント差で半荘ごとに精算。アカギの致死量2000ccは点棒2万点に相当し、鷺巣の現有資産5億円は50万点に相当する。
- ガラス牌……1種4牌のうち3枚が透明ガラス牌。
- ボーナス払い……半荘精算以外にも、アカギと鷺巣の間で直接点棒の移動があった場合には、その局ごとに血液or現金をやりとりする。
- 鷺巣側の特例……半荘2回を区切りとして勝負を続行するか途中終了するかを、鷺巣側のみ選択できる。
